The application form

10. §

- (1) The admission procedure shall be initiated at the request of the applicant.
- (2)*The application may be submitted to the Office using the electronic form provided by the Office for this purpose, with identification and authentication via the customer portal.
- (2a)*The data provided by the applicant on the personal administration interface, the data obtained from the public database, and the data recorded on the basis of the documents shall form the basis for the application and the scoring.
- (2b)*In the case of a certified application, the additional procedural fee payable under Section 53(5) of the Regulations may be paid after the application deadline, up to the 15th day following the deadline.
- (3) Applicants shall upload the documents available to them at the time of submission of the application (received earlier) – to be submitted for the assessment of the application – to the IT system provided for this purpose by the Office.
- (4) In the case of courses advertised for foreign nationals and conducted in a foreign language, the application must be sent to the faculty advertising the course, which will be responsible for conducting the admission procedure and shall inform the Office of the applicants' details and the results of the admission procedure via the Higher Education Information System by the start of the training, but no later than October 15.
- (5) Foreign nationals who are citizens of a foreign country or who do not have a Hungarian secondary school leaving certificate may apply for programs advertised for foreign nationals and conducted in a foreign language.
- (6) Applicants may submit one valid application in the admission procedure.

The application must contain the following:

- a) the applicant's first and last name,
- b) the applicant's first and last name at birth,
- c) the applicant's mother's first and last name at birth,
- d) the applicant's place of birth (country, town),
- e) the applicant's date of birth,
- f) the applicant's nationality,
- g) the applicant's gender,**
- h) the applicant's place of residence, place of stay, contact address, and email address.

13. § (1) Based on the data provided and verified during the electronic application process, as well as the data indicated on the submitted documents, the Office shall create a central register of applicants (Freshmen database).
